Thermoline Retroreflective Hot Melt

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Type: A combination of plasticized resin, aggregate, pigment and glass beads supplied in powder form. Conforms to the British Standards (BS) specifications, 3262: Part 1/1989 and Kenya Standard KS 2157-1: 2008.

Uses: Designed for use as markings for road safety and traffic control

Substrates: Bitumen and properly primed concrete roads.

Advantages: High day and night retro-reflectivity and visibility. Fast drying - less traffic disruption during application. Excellent adhesion. High durability. Good flow and skid resistance. Non - toxic. One coat application. Cost effective.

Conditions during application; The temperature of the substrate should be minimum 10°C and at least 3°C above the dew point of the air, measured near the substrate. Good ventilation is usually required in confined areas to ensure proper drying. The moisture content in the substrate should not exceed 3% (by weight). The coating should not be exposed to oil, chemicals or mechanical stress until fully cured.

APPLICATION DATA:

The product can be applied by: By screed, special spray equipment or extruder.

Application: Heat the material to 160-190°C in the heater with adequate agitation till the material becomes a homogenized liquid. On aged asphalt roads and concrete roads application of Thermoplastic Primer coat is recommended for proper bonding of the material with the road surface. Ensure that the primer is thoroughly dry and void of solvent prior to application of the thermoplastic material. Ensure temperature of 160 – 190°C and adequate agitation during application. Drop-on glass beads must be immediately deposited after thermoplastic application.

Spreading Capacity per coat: Depends on film thickness applied, type of texture, surface porosity, imperfections, temperature & wastage during painting

4 - $8kg/m^2$ at 1.5 - 3 mm film thickness.

^{*}The application of Thermoline on concrete is not highly recommended as it may result in poor adhesion and cracking. We recommend Acrylic Road Marking or Water based Road Marking Paint on concrete

Precautions:

- 1. Do not hold thermoplastic above 180°C for more than 6 hours.
- 2. Do not heat the material above 200°C at any time or decomposition of the material occurs.
- 3. Change in colour indicates that the material has been scorched owing to overheating and needs to be discarded.
